## Dear Requester

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

- Copies of all Mileage claims made by Minister Flanagan in the Calendar year 2017.
- Any records relating to the provision of a "fresh start" to Minister Flanagan for the purposed of calculating his mileage in 2017.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017.

I am the deciding officer for your request.

Ministerial mileage expenses are paid in accordance with rates and regulations set down by the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform.

Mileage expenses are a monthly total and reflect business related travel across Ireland during the respective month, and incorporate deductions for any personal-related travel.

I have identified 6 records that fall within the scope of your request. The records are listed in the schedule attached.
