Japan's tentative comments on

Draft Political Declaration on Strengthening the Protection of Civilians from Humanitarian Harm arising from the use of Explosive Weapons in Populated <u>Areas</u>

The following comments from Japan are not exhaustive and without prejudice to Japan's position on this political declaration.

- Japan requests for clarification on the meaning of the similar but different terms in this draft, namely, "<u>populated area</u>" and "<u>urban area</u>", as well as "<u>armed conflict</u>", "<u>hostilities</u>", and "<u>warfare</u>". Words and phrases should be consistent throughout the declaration.
- Japan would like to confirm that this document is not legally binding. (such revision as from "agree" to "specify" in paragraph 4.1)
- In addition to the comments presented above, Japan would like to reiterate its comments made on the Principles in February, although those comments are not exhaustive.
